

ENSC mini-GSA Travel Grant Eligibility and Requirements

The Environmental Science mini-GSA (ENSC mini-GSA) is proud to announce the ability to award travel funds that may be used to attend a conference, workshop, other research facility, or other purpose that has an educational component. Funding may only be used to reimburse travel, accommodation, or registration fees and in no circumstance will an award exceed actual expenses incurred.

Maximum Award

Awards will be administered on a first-come first-served basis and will be distributed until funds run out. The total funds awarded to a student in a given academic year (Sept. – Aug.) is capped at \$750, and each individual award will be capped according to the travel destination as follows:

Within California, Arizona, Nevada	\$250 per person
North America (including Canada, Mexico)	\$500 per person
Outside of North America (including HI, AK)	\$750 per person

Eligibility

To be eligible for this award, you must:

- Be a graduate student in Soil and Water Sciences or in Environmental Sciences
- Be a currently enrolled student
- Be attending an event that will enhance your education in your graduate program
- Have not already met your \$750 per year cap for this award

How to Apply

To apply for this award, you must submit a signed ENSC mini-GSA Travel Grant Application Form two weeks prior to the start of your event.

Please submit the application by email, in person, or in the ENSC mini-GSA mailbox (room 2306) to a current mini-GSA Co-Chair. You will be notified if your request is denied.

Reimbursement

If your travel grant application is approved, please submit an ENSC mini-GSA Travel Grant Expense Report Form and all associated receipts to a current mini-GSA Co-Chair after the event takes place.
